‘Skinny Brexit’ for Retailers Scenario Planning Session

In advance of the 2018 BRC annual Brexit debate, Pinsent Masons will host a **roundtable discussion** which will ask the critical question: **what are the essential elements of a Brexit deal for retailers?**
