


CONTACTLESS PAYMENTS

From 15 October 2021, the contactless card payment limit is increasing to £100. Contactless is a fast, easy and secure way to pay by card or device without having to enter a PIN.

The new £100 limit means greater choice for customers at the checkout, with contactless cards now an option for more expensive purchases like the weekly shop or tank of fuel.



15 OCTOBER

The increase will roll-out from 15 October 2021, however, with hundreds of thousands of payment terminals to update, it may not be available for every retailer on day one.



To check if a retailer has updated to the new limit, customers should either ask in store or follow the prompts on the card payment machine when paying. If the value is above the limit, the payment will default to a chip & PIN payment for card, or, if available, payment via mobile phone.



There are security features built into every contactless card and customers are fully protected against any unauthorised fraud.



There are alternative ways to pay, without the £100 limit, for example through chip & PIN, cash and mobile payments like Apple Pay or Google Pay.






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
