- Chemical contaminants Craig will share a readout ahead of the meeting. We've asked for information on the acrylamide data call as we hear work is progressing and they will be reaching out in due course.
- **Smoke flavourings** the smoke flavourings are still in the risk assessment phase. The assessment will be in 2 phases smoke flavourings with genotoxicity concerns will be unauthorised and any not in this would go to the 2nd part of the assessment. Until the FSA know the outcomes of these safety assessments they won't have anything new to share.
- Food fraud & authenticity Devina attended part of the food authenticity conferences from 11th/12th February and can share a summary of notes ahead of the meeting, including a new publication on honey authenticity.
- Novel foods We got in touch with Sonalika about the Novel Foods Expert Network (NFX UK) and share the attachment sent on more about the project. We've asked for any updates in the upcoming months.
